RESPONSIBILITIES

Mechanical Maintenance

- Inspect mechanical systems and equipment such as the depulper, pasteurizer, filling machine, liquid chiller etc. to diagnose and identify issues or defects.
- Repair/replace defective or worn mechanical components such as bearings, gears, and valves.
- Maintain and service the above-mentioned mechanical systems and equipment to ensure they operate efficiently and safely.
- Read and interpret technical manuals and schematics to understand mechanical systems and equipment.

- Collaborate with other technicians and engineers to implement maintenance and repair plans.
- Perform preventative maintenance on mechanical systems and equipment to minimize downtime and prevent failures.

Documentation

- Document maintenance and repair activities in logs and databases for tracking and reporting purposes.
